Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to the Land of Abundance & Chengdu Arrival

Welcome to **Chengdu**, the heart of Sichuan province and a city renowned for its laid-back lifestyle, world-class gastronomy, and, of course, its most famous residents—the Giant Pandas.

Arrival & Warm Welcome: Upon your arrival at Chengdu Shuangliu (CTU) or Tianfu (TFU) International Airport—or any of the city's major train stations—your **private local guide and driver** will be waiting at the arrival hall to greet you. You will be escorted in a comfortable, private vehicle directly to your hotel for a seamless check-in process. Our team will assist with your luggage and provide an orientation of the local neighborhood to help you settle in.

A Relaxing Introduction: The rest of the day is yours to unwind from your travels and embrace the city's "slow-paced" philosophy. You might choose to relax at your hotel or take a preliminary stroll through the nearby streets. Chengdu is a city where tradition meets modernity; you will see futuristic skyscrapers standing alongside ancient tea houses, all while the scent of spicy Sichuan peppercorns lingers in the air.

Expert Tips for Day 1:

*Chengdu now operates with two major airports; please note that **Tianfu International Airport (TFU)** is approximately 60–90 minutes from the city center, while **Shuangliu (CTU)** is much closer. Your private transfer ensures a stress-free journey regardless of your arrival point. If you arrive early, we highly recommend heading to a **local tea house** in People's Park. Sitting on a bamboo chair with a cup of jasmine tea is the most authentic way to witness the local lifestyle. For your first dinner, try a mild version of Sichuan cuisine to let your palate adjust to the famous local spices!*

Day 2: Panda Encounters & The World's Largest Buddha

Today is a day of extraordinary highlights, featuring China's most beloved national treasure and a staggering monument of ancient faith.

Morning: A Heartwarming Morning with Pandas: Your journey begins early at the **Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding**. This world-class facility mimics the pandas' natural habitat with lush bamboo forests and rolling hills. You will have the chance to see dozens of giant pandas during their most active time of the day—breakfast. Watch as they playfully tumble, climb trees, and munch on fresh bamboo. If you are lucky, you may even witness the tiny, pink panda babies in the specialized nursery rooms, an unforgettable sight of conservation in action.

Afternoon: The Colossal Leshan Giant Buddha: After a scenic 2-hour drive, arrive in Leshan for a local lunch before witnessing the awe-inspiring **Leshan Giant Buddha**. Carved into the red sandstone cliffs during the Tang Dynasty, this 71-meter-high statue is the largest stone-carved Buddha in the world. You will embark on a **river cruise** at the confluence of the Minjiang, Dadu, and Qingyi Rivers. This vantage point offers the most spectacular panoramic view, allowing you to appreciate the Buddha's immense scale—where "the mountain is a Buddha and the Buddha is a mountain."

Expert Tips for Day 2:

To get the best experience at the Panda Base, we maintain an early start. Pandas are sensitive to heat and tend to sleep in the afternoon, so arriving when the gates open ensures you see them at their most playful. In Leshan, the boat tour is highly recommended as it avoids the long, steep queues on the cliffside stairs and provides a perfect "full-body" photo opportunity of the Buddha. Please keep your camera ready as you approach the confluence; the contrasting colors of the three merging rivers create a unique natural backdrop for this spiritual monument.

Day 3: Ancient Engineering Miracles & Taoist Serenity

Today, you will transition from the monumental scale of Leshan to the intricate wisdom of ancient water management and the spiritual tranquility of a Taoist forest.

Morning: A Living Heritage at Dujiangyan: After breakfast, we drive to the **Dujiangyan Irrigation System**. This UNESCO World Heritage site is a 2,000-year-old masterpiece of ancient Chinese engineering that still functions today, shielding the region from floods and nurturing the "Land of Abundance." You will explore the ingenious **Fish Mouth Levee**, which intelligently divides the river's waters, and the **Feishayan Spillway**. Walking across the Anlan Suspension Bridge offers a thrilling perspective of this eco-friendly system that relies on natural topography rather than modern dams.

Afternoon: The Mystic Trails of Mount Qingcheng: Following a local lunch, find your inner peace at **Mount Qingcheng (Front Mountain)**. As the birthplace of Taoism, this mountain is famous for being "the most secluded place under heaven." You will wander through emerald-green forests, pass by quiet crystalline lakes, and visit ancient **Taoist temples** tucked away in the mist. The atmosphere here is thick with history and spirituality, providing a cool, refreshing escape from the urban world. After soaking in the serene energy, you will be escorted back to the comforts of your hotel in downtown Chengdu.

At Dujiangyan, your guide will take you to the best vantage points to clearly see how the water is diverted—it's much easier to understand the genius of the system from a height! For Mount Qingcheng, we highly recommend utilizing the cable car for the ascent to save your energy for exploring the historic temples at the summit. The mountain paths can be damp and mossy, so please ensure you wear comfortable walking shoes with good traction. If time permits, enjoying a cup of local green tea at one of the mountain-top tea houses is a quintessential Sichuan experience that perfectly complements the Taoist surroundings.

Your journey through the adorable wildlife, ancient wonders, and spiritual landscapes of Sichuan concludes today as we ensure your transition to your next destination is smooth and comfortable.
