Expert Tips for Day 1:

*Please note that the new Siem Reap-Angkor International Airport (SAI) is located approximately 45-60 minutes from the city center. Your private transfer is the most comfortable and reliable way to reach your hotel after a long flight. If you arrive in the afternoon and feel energetic, we recommend a stroll through the **Old Market (Phsar Chas)** area to get a feel for the local rhythm. Our team monitors all flight statuses in real-time, so your guide will be there to meet you even if your flight is delayed.*

Day 2: The Majesty of Angkor & Cultural Immersion

Today is a journey through time as you explore the colossal stone masterpieces and jungle-clad ruins of the Angkor Archaeological Park.

Morning: Jungle Temples & Hidden Passages: Your adventure begins at **Banteay Kdei**, a quiet, sprawling monastic complex that offers a peaceful start to the day. From there, you will head to the world-famous **Ta Prohm**. Unlike other temples, Ta Prohm has been left to the clutches of the jungle, where massive silk-cotton trees and strangler figs grow directly out of the ruins—a breathtaking sight made famous by cinema.

Afternoon: The Lost Capital & Divine Faces: After a local lunch, enter the grand walled city of **Angkor Thom** through the monumental **Victory Gate**. You will explore the heart of this ancient capital, including the **Terrace of the Leper King**, the **Royal Palace**, and the enigmatic **Bayon Temple**, famous for its 54 towers adorned with over 200 serene, smiling stone faces. Your temple exploration concludes at the impressive **Preah Khan**, a labyrinthine complex built by King Jayavarman VII to honor his father.

Evening: Apsara Dance & Traditional Flavors: As the sun sets, experience the grace of Cambodian culture with a traditional **Apsara Dancing Show** paired with a buffet dinner. Watch as performers in shimmering silk costumes bring ancient legends to life through intricate hand gestures and movements. To add to the local charm, you will be transported to the venue by a **Tuk-Tuk**, the most iconic and fun way to navigate the streets of Siem Reap.

To respect the sacred nature of the Angkor temples, a strict dress code is required: please ensure your shoulders and knees are covered (scarves or sarongs are acceptable). We recommend wearing breathable, light-colored clothing and sturdy walking shoes, as the temple stones can be uneven and the tropical sun intense. Your private guide will carry chilled bottled water for you, but we also suggest bringing a hat and sunscreen. For the best photos at Ta Prohm, your guide will lead you through the lesser-known entrances to avoid the main tour groups.

Your journey through the ancient mysteries and vibrant culture of Cambodia concludes today with a smooth and comfortable transition to your next destination.

A Final Morning in Siem Reap: After a leisurely breakfast at your hotel, enjoy some free time to soak in the final moments of your Cambodian adventure. You may choose to wander through the **Old Market (Phsar Chas)** to pick up unique handcrafted souvenirs, explore the local artisan boutiques for high-quality silk, or simply relax at a riverside café and reflect on the memories of the past few days.

*For last-minute shopping, we recommend visiting **Artisans Angkor** or the **Old Market** for authentic local crafts like stone carvings, silver jewelry, and Kampot pepper. Please be aware that the new Siem Reap-Angkor International Airport (SAI) is approximately 50km from the city center, which takes about an hour by car. Your private transfer will be scheduled accordingly to ensure you have plenty of time for check-in and security. We recommend double-checking your travel documents and any VAT refund forms before leaving the hotel—our team is happy to assist if you need any final guidance.*
