Day 1: Arrival in Kuala Lumpur & Private Transfer to Downtown

Day 2: Kuala Lumpur City Discovery & Drive to Malacca

Day 3: Malacca UNESCO Heritage Discovery & Scenic River Cruise

- **The Stadthuys (Dutch Red Square):** Admire the iconic terracotta-red buildings, the oldest remaining Dutch architecture in Southeast Asia. Here, you'll also experience Melaka's unique **Rickshaw Culture**—vibrantly decorated trishaws that offer a colorful and musical way to see the square.
- **St. Paul's Hill & Church:** A short walk uphill leads to the ruins of St. Paul's Church. Built by the Portuguese in 1521, it is the oldest European church building in Southeast Asia. Though only the bullet-scarred walls remain, the site offers a poignant look at Malacca's turbulent past and stunning views of the city.
- **A Famosa Fortress:** Visit the surviving gate (Porta de Santiago) of this once-mighty Portuguese fortress, one of the oldest European architectural remains in Asia.

Noon: Culinary Immersion at Jonker Street Next, we dive into the heart of the city: **Jonker Street**. This bustling heritage street is a paradise for food lovers.

- **Must-Try Delicacies:**

- **Jonker 88's Baba Cendol:** A refreshing dessert made with rich Malacca palm sugar (Gula Melaka) and red beans.
- **Bunga Raya Popiah:** Famous for its generous size and crispy pork lard filling.
- **Hoe Kee Chicken Rice Balls:** A Malacca specialty featuring succulent chicken and fragrant rice hand-rolled into balls—a favorite among local gourmets.

Afternoon: Melaka River Cruise & Return to KL In the afternoon, experience the city from a different perspective with a **Melaka River Cruise**.

- **The Cruise Experience:** During this 40-minute journey, you will glide past ancient stone bridges, vibrant mural-covered houses, and the neo-Gothic **Church of St. Francis Xavier**. on-site restaurant.

Dining Recommendation: Authentic Nyonya Cuisine For an unforgettable dinner, head to **Niang Penang**, a local favorite specializing in traditional **Peranakan (Nyonya) cuisine**.

- **Atmosphere:** The elegant, cozy interior features antique vases and hanging paper umbrellas, setting the stage for a nostalgic dining experience.
- **Must-Order Dishes:** Under the guidance of an 80-year-old "Aunty" chef, the kitchen serves up incredibly authentic flavors. We highly recommend:
 - **Kangkong Sambal with Shrimp:** Spicy and aromatic.
 - **Curry Chicken:** Rich with coconut milk and local spices.
 - **Loh Bak:** Crispy meat rolls that are a staple of Penang street food.
 - **Sambal Udang:** Tangy and spicy prawns that perfectly capture the Peranakan spirit.

Day 5: Penang Heritage Discovery & Panoramic Views from Penang Hill
