Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Sri Lanka & Coastal Retreat in Negombo

Upon your arrival at **Bandaranaike International Airport (CMB)**, your dedicated **private driver-guide** will be waiting at the arrival hall. Explore Negombo at Your Leisure Negombo faces the vast **Indian Ocean**, offering the perfect sunset backdrop.

- **Currency & Exchange (LKR):** The **Sri Lankan Rupee (LKR)** is the local currency.
 - **Pro Tip:** Exchange your USD/EUR at the airport counters upon arrival—they offer competitive rates and 24-hour service.
 - **Cash is King:** While hotels accept cards, local markets and small eateries operate on cash. Avoid using cards at small street vendors to ensure security.
 - **Note:** Banks usually have limited hours (9:00 AM – 1:00 PM), so the airport remains the most convenient option.

Day 2: Coastal Heritage to Cultural Triangle – Dambulla & Sigiriya

- **Lellama Fishing Village:** Stroll through this tranquil seaside community. Meet the hospitable locals—often called the "Land of Smiles"—and observe the age-old craft of net mending and boat repair.

- **The Dutch Canal (Hamilton Canal):** Explore the historic 120km waterway built during the colonial era. Today, a scenic 9km stretch remains, lined with vibrant bungalows and colorful boats, offering a peaceful glimpse into Sri Lanka's colonial past.

Afternoon: The Spiritual Grandeur of Dambulla After a 3-hour scenic drive into the heart of the **Cultural Triangle**, we reach a masterpiece of ancient Buddhist art.

- **Dambulla Cave Temple (UNESCO World Heritage):** Perched on a hillside with sweeping vistas of the surrounding jungle and distant **Lion Rock**, this 2,000-year-old complex consists of five majestic caves.
