Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to the Soul of Nepal – Kathmandu Arrival

Welcome to Nepal! Upon your arrival at **Kathmandu Tribhuvan International Airport**, your dedicated tour guide will meet you at a designated location on time, holding a personalized pickup board. You will then be escorted to a comfortable private car or bus, where your driver will provide a seamless transfer to your hotel.

The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure. Whether you choose to have a restorative rest after your flight or take a gentle stroll through the vibrant streets of the city to soak in the local atmosphere, the time is yours to spend as you wish.

Expert Tips:

For your first evening in Kathmandu, the Thamel district is a fantastic place to wander for a wide variety of local and international dining options. If you are arriving from a long-haul flight, staying

hydrated is key to acclimating to the elevation of the Kathmandu Valley. Your guide can also recommend reliable spots for currency exchange or help you pick up a local SIM card if needed during your transfer.

Day 2: Kathmandu Valley – Heritage Markets & Medieval Squares

After breakfast at your hotel, you will begin your exploration of the **Kathmandu Valley**, a historic region housing Nepal's three most significant ancient cities. Your first stop is the vibrant **Ason Tole Vegetable and Spice Market**, a sensory-rich hub where you can observe the authentic daily life and trading traditions of the local people.

Later, you will visit the magnificent **Kathmandu Durbar Square**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site designated in 1979. Here, you will explore the **Kumari Temple**, home of the Living Goddess, and view the architectural grandeur of the **Taleju Temple** and the **Kal Bhairav** monument from the outside.

In the afternoon, a short drive brings you to the city of **Patan** to explore **Patan Durbar Square**, renowned for its exquisite Newari architecture. You will then visit the **Swayambhunath Stupa** (the Monkey Temple), the most ancient and enigmatic of all holy shrines in the valley, offering panoramic views of the city. Finally, return to your hotel in Kathmandu for the evening.

Expert Tips:

For your visit to Ason Tole, we recommend wearing closed-toe shoes as the market alleys can be busy and occasionally damp. At Swayambhunath, be mindful of your belongings—especially food or shiny objects—as the resident monkeys are quite curious and bold. To fully respect the spiritual atmosphere at the stupas, always walk around them in a clockwise direction.

Day 3: Spiritual Wonders & The Medieval Art of Bhaktapur

After breakfast, you will depart your hotel for the **Boudhanath Stupa**, known in Nepalese as "Chorten Chenpo." This massive monument consists of a giant dome topped with the iconic painted eyes of the Buddha, representing his all-seeing nature. Your journey continues to **Pashupatinath**, the largest Hindu temple complex dedicated to Lord Shiva and revered as the "Temple of Living Beings."

In the afternoon, a drive takes you to the historic city of **Bhaktapur** to explore **Bhaktapur Durbar Square**, famous for its exquisite woodcarvings and medieval atmosphere. You will then admire the **Changu Narayan Temple**, an artistic and historic masterpiece that holds a place among the seven structures on the UNESCO World Heritage List for the Kathmandu Valley. Following your exploration, you will return to your hotel in Kathmandu.

Expert Tips:

When visiting Pashupatinath, please be aware that the main temple is accessible only to Hindus; however, visitors can observe the complex and sacred cremation rituals from across the Bagmati River. In Bhaktapur, we recommend trying the famous "Juju Dhau" (King Curd), a local yogurt

specialty. To support the preservation of these historic sites, ensure you keep your entry tickets handy, as they may be checked at various points within the Durbar Square.

Day 4: Final Moments in Kathmandu & Departure

Enjoy your final breakfast in the Kathmandu Valley and take advantage of some leisure time for last-minute souvenir shopping or a final stroll through the local markets. At the scheduled time, your guide will meet you and provide a comfortable transfer to the airport for your departure flight, marking the conclusion of your 4-day Nepal discovery.

Expert Tips:

For your final hours, we recommend visiting the Thamel area if you are looking for high-quality pashminas or local tea to bring home. Please ensure you have all your travel documents ready; your guide will assist you with the drop-off at the terminal to ensure a smooth check-in process. We recommend arriving at Tribhuvan International Airport at least three hours before your international flight to allow for security and immigration procedures.
