Day 1: Beijing Airport to Mutianyu Great Wall – A World Wonder in a Day

Arrival | Meet & Greet at the Airport Your private guide and driver will meet you right at the arrivals hall of **PEK or PKX Airport**. With a personalized name sign and a comfortable vehicle waiting, we ensure a swift departure to the Great Wall (approx. 1.5 - 2 hours), maximizing your limited transit time.

The Experience | Choose Your Path to the Peak Mutianyu is famous for its versatility. After a short shuttle ride from the park entrance, a pleasant 600-meter scenic stroll leads you to the base of the Wall. From here, you can choose how to conquer the mountain:

- **Option 1: The Fun & Thrill (Chairlift Up & Toboggan Down)** Take a two-seater chairlift to **Watchtower No. 6**. After exploring, enjoy the highlight of Mutianyu—a thrilling **Toboggan (slide) ride** down the winding track. Perfect for families and those looking for a bit of excitement!

- **Option 2: The Comfort & View (Cable Car Round-trip)** The most popular choice for a relaxing experience. Take the enclosed cable car directly to **Watchtower No. 14**. It offers the smoothest ride and the best panoramic views for photography without the strenuous climb.
- **Option 3: The Hiker's Challenge (Hiking on Foot)** For those looking to stretch their legs after a long flight, a 30-minute steady uphill hike through the forest brings you to **Watchtower No. 8 or No. 10**. A true "boots-on-the-ground" experience!

The Highlight | The Most Scenic Stretch (Watchtowers 14–23) Once on the Wall, we recommend the hike between **Watchtower No. 14 and No. 23**. This section is widely considered the most beautiful, offering the classic "winding dragon" silhouette of the Great Wall against the lush mountains.

- *Pro Tip:* Hike east to Watchtower 23 for breathtaking views, then retrace your steps to your preferred descent point.

Lunch & Return | Worry-Free Transfer After descending, enjoy a **hearty local lunch** at the foot of the mountain (optional) before your private driver whisks you back to the airport. We monitor your flight schedule in real-time to ensure you are back at the terminal at least 2-3 hours before your departure.
