You will be escorted in a comfortable, private vehicle directly to your hotel for a seamless check-in. Our team will assist with your luggage and provide a brief orientation to the historic neighborhood surrounding your hotel.

*Please note that Xi'an is a major transport hub; our team monitors your flight or high-speed train status in real-time to ensure your driver is waiting, regardless of any travel delays. If you arrive in the afternoon and feel energetic, we recommend heading to the **Grand Tang Dynasty Everbright City** (near the Big Wild Goose Pagoda) in the evening. It is one of China's most spectacular pedestrian streets, featuring dazzling light shows and performances that bring the glory of the Tang Dynasty to life—a perfect first impression of the city's night charm.*

Day 2: Treasures of the Tang Dynasty & Vibrant Local Life

Today is a journey through the golden age of Chinese history, exploring spiritual landmarks and the culinary heart of the ancient capital.

Morning: Civilized Roots & Sacred Heights: Your exploration begins at the **Shaanxi Provincial History Museum**, a "treasure house" of Chinese civilization. In the Muslim Quarter, don't miss the famous "Roujiamo" (Chinese burger) or the refreshing plum juice—your guide can point out the most authentic stalls favored by locals to avoid the tourist traps. For the evening show, we recommend bringing a light wrap as the theater can be cool with air conditioning. If you wish to capture the Bell Tower's best angle, the exterior illuminations at

night provide a stunning backdrop for photography.

Day 3: The Terracotta Army & Ancient City Ramparts

Today, you will stand face-to-face with one of the most significant archaeological discoveries of the 20th century before bidding farewell to this historic capital.

Morning: The Underground Empire: Your morning is dedicated to the awe-inspiring **Terracotta Warriors Museum**. After a comfortable drive to the outskirts of the city, you will explore the three massive excavation pits that house thousands of life-size clay soldiers, horses, and chariots, each with unique facial features. Your **private guide** will reveal the fascinating history behind this "ghost army" built to protect China's first emperor in the afterlife, including a close-up look at the incredibly detailed bronze chariots and horses.

Expert Tips for Day 3:

To avoid the heaviest crowds at the Terracotta Warriors, we recommend an early start. Photography is encouraged, but please remember that flash is strictly prohibited to protect the ancient pigments on the figures. When visiting the Ancient City Wall, there is very little shade on top; we suggest bringing a hat and sunglasses, especially if you plan to cycle the full loop. Your guide will ensure your departure transfer is timed perfectly with local traffic conditions, allowing you to relax and enjoy your final hours in the city.
