Itinerary

Day 1: The Epic Trek Begins — Gubeikou's Wild Splendor

Summary: Leave the modern world behind as you embark on a legendary 10km trek. Starting from the raw, wind-swept ruins of Gubeikou, you will witness the Great Wall in its most authentic form—unrestored, untamed, and breathtakingly beautiful.

07:30 | Expedition Kick-off

Your professional hiking guide and private driver will meet you at your hotel lobby. As we escape the city bustle, enjoy a comfortable **2.5-hour drive** through the scenic mountain outskirts of Beijing. During the journey, your guide will provide a deep historical briefing on the Great Wall's strategic importance, preparing you for the ancient stones you are about to tread upon.

10:00 | Setting Foot on Gubeikou (The Unrestored Path)

Our hike commences at the **Gubeikou section** in Miyun County. Unlike the manicured tourist spots, Gubeikou remains a "Wild Wall" sanctuary. Though designated as a park, it is **completely unrestored**, offering a visceral connection to the Ming Dynasty.

- **Architecture in Ruins:** This section is home to over **140 watchtowers**, each uniquely designed and standing in various states of evocative decay.
- **The Stone Dragon:** From your first vantage point, you will see the Wall twisting and winding with serpentine grace along the knife-edge ridges of the steep mountain ranges.
- **The Experience:** This is the quietest part of the trek, where the only sound is the rustle of nature, allowing you to absorb the true scale of this ancient military wonder before we head toward the majestic towers of Jinshanling.
