

2-Day Jiankou Wild Great Wall Camping Tour

Trip overview

Itinerary

Day 1: Ascent to the Wild Wall – Sunset, Stars & BBQ Feast

15:00 | Escape the City Grate

Your adventure begins in the mid-afternoon. Your private guide and driver will meet you at your Beijing hotel, whisking you away from the urban bustle. As the skyscrapers fade into the rearview mirror, you'll head north into the rugged Huairou mountains. The 2.5-hour scenic drive takes you to **Xizhaizi Village**, a secluded hamlet cradled at the foot of the legendary Jiankou section.

17:30 | The Rewarding Trek to the Ridge

Leave the pavement behind. To reach the most authentic part of the Great Wall, you'll embark on a **1-hour hike** up a winding mountain path. As you emerge from the forest canopy, the unrestored, "wild" silhouette of Jiankou reveals itself—jagged, majestic, and free from the modern hand of restoration.

18:30 | The Golden Hour: BBQ Dinner & Sunset Toasts

While day-trippers are heading back to the city, you are just getting started. This is the highlight of the day: **a private BBQ dinner served on the Great Wall itself.**

- **A Feast with a View:** Savor grilled delicacies and chilled beer (or your favorite beverage) as the sun begins its slow descent.
- **Photographer's Dream:** Watch as the "Golden Hour" transforms the crumbling limestone watchtowers into a fiery masterpiece of light and shadow. It's a moment of profound silence and beauty that few travelers ever witness.

20:00 | Sleeping Under the Canopy of History

As the stars begin to blanket the sky, far from the light pollution of Beijing, you'll settle into your campsite.

08:00 | The Ultimate Trek: From Wild Jiankou to Restored Mutianyu

Lace up your boots for a world-class hiking experience. Today, you will traverse the "Dragon's Back," moving from the raw, unrestored ruins of **Jiankou** to the magnificently preserved battlements of **Mutianyu**.

- **The Challenge:** This is an authentic trek—expect steep ascents, rocky trails, and varied terrain that will test your spirit and reward your camera.
- **The Contrast:** Witness the dramatic transition of the Wall. You'll leave behind the crumbling watchtowers overtaken by nature and emerge onto the grand, crenelated ramparts that have

made the Great Wall a Wonder of the World.

12:30 | Celebration Lunch: Countryside Flavors

After descending from the heights, we'll head to a hand-picked local restaurant at the foot of Mutianyu. Celebrate your physical feat with a **hearty, rustic Chinese lunch** featuring fresh, local ingredients—the perfect way to refuel after your trek.

14:00 | Relaxed Return to Beijing
