Today offers a deep dive into the soul of Shanghai, spanning thousands of years of art and a breathtaking skyline that defines the future.

Morning: Cultural Treasures & Vibrant Streets: Your exploration begins at **People's Square**, the city's green heart. Here, you will visit the **Shanghai Museum**, a world-class sanctuary of ancient Chinese art.
