Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Lhasa – Welcome to the Holy City (3,650m)

Welcome to Tibet! Your journey to the "Roof of the World" begins today. Upon your arrival at Lhasa Gonggar Airport or the railway station, you will be warmly greeted by our professional Tibetan guide. In keeping with ancient tradition, you will be presented with a **Hada**—a ceremonial white silk scarf that carries our best wishes for your safe and auspicious journey.

After a celebratory group photo to mark the start of your adventure, we will transfer you to your hotel in a comfortable vehicle. The one-hour drive provides your first glimpse of the dramatic Tibetan landscape, where the sparkling Yarlung Tsangpo River flows past traditional villages and rugged mountain silhouettes.

The remainder of the day is dedicated to **rest and acclimatization**. To help your body adjust to the high altitude, we recommend taking things easy, staying well-hydrated, and moving at a relaxed pace. Relax in your hotel and soak in the serene atmosphere of Lhasa as you prepare for the cultural wonders of the days ahead.

Stay overnight in Lhasa.

Day 2: Lhasa City Highlights – Potala Palace, Jokhang Temple, and Barkhor Street

We begin our morning at the majestic **Potala Palace**, often called "a golden feather upon the roof of the world." This architectural wonder has stood as a symbol of Tibet since the 7th century, when it was first established by the 33rd King of Tibet, Songtsen Gampo. As you explore its labyrinthine halls, you will encounter the palace's most precious treasures: the jewel-encrusted **gilded burial stupas** of former Dalai Lamas and the ancient **Meditation Cave** of the King. The panoramic view of Lhasa city from the palace heights is equally breathtaking.

In the afternoon, we head to the **Jokhang Temple**, the ultimate tour destination and the spiritual heart of Tibetan Buddhism. Every day, adventurers from the farthest corners of the plateau gather here to show their devotion. The temple's most venerated treasure is the life-sized **statue of Jowo Sakyamuni** (Buddha at age twelve), brought to Tibet in the 7th century. The air inside, filled with the scent of yak butter lamps and rhythmic chanting, creates an atmosphere of profound serenity.

Finally, we immerse ourselves in the vibrant energy of **Barkhor Street**. This ancient circuit surrounding the Jokhang Temple is both a bustling marketplace and a sacred path. You can join the local adventurers in their *walking*, watch devotees performing traditional prostrations, or browse the colorful stalls for authentic Tibetan handicrafts and souvenirs.

Stay overnight in Lhasa.

Day 3: Rural Traditions & Monastic Philosophy – Dadong Village and Sera Monastery

Today, we journey just 25 kilometers outside the city center to **Dadong Village**, widely celebrated as the most beautiful and well-preserved traditional village in the Lhasa region. This morning is dedicated to experiencing the authentic rhythm of Tibetan country life. We will visit the ancient **Nyimatang Monastery** and enjoy a leisure walk through the valley to visit a **local Tibetan family**. Here, you will be welcomed into a traditional home to learn about their customs and enjoy a delicious, **authentic Tibetan lunch**, providing a rare and intimate glimpse into the local lifestyle.

In the afternoon, we head to the edge of town to explore **Sera Monastery**, one of the "Great Three" Gelug university monasteries of Tibet. Founded in 1419, Sera has long been a prestigious center for Buddhist learning. The highlight of your visit—and perhaps the entire tour—is witnessing the **famous Monk Debates** held in the courtyard (typically between 15:00 and 17:00). Watch as monks engage in spirited philosophical discussions, using dramatic hand claps and gestures to punctuate their logic. It is a captivating display of intellectual energy and a tradition that has remained unchanged for centuries.

Stay overnight in Lhasa.

Day 4: Farewell to the Holy City – Departure from Lhasa

Your unforgettable exploration of the "Roof of the World" concludes today. After enjoying a final Tibetan breakfast, our guide and driver will provide a **private transfer** to **Lhasa Gonggar Airport** or the **Lhasa Railway Station**, according to your departure schedule.

Our team will assist you with the check-in procedures to ensure your departure is as smooth and stress-free as your journey has been. As you leave the high plateau, we hope the spiritual peace of the Potala Palace and the warm smiles of the Tibetan people remain with you as lifelong memories.
